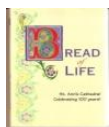

### WANT A BETTER WAY TO KNOW, LOVE AND SERVE GOD?

Eucharistic Adoration is the adoration of Jesus Christ Himself, present in the Holy Eucharist. During Adoration, the Eucharist is exposed in a beautiful golden vessel called a monstrance. From the altar, our Lord gazes at us in the Eucharist wanting for us to give Him our hearts, our burdens, our sufferings, our joys and our sorrows so that He may transform us and sanctify us. In the silence of our hearts, we are able to go before Him and love and adore Him simply



because He is God.

St. Ann's offers Eucharistic Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament every Tuesday from 12:30pm to 8:00pm. At present, we have one time slot that need to be filled.
